

K6 Experience Studio Guide/teachers

Purpose/Mission

Our goal in K6 Experience Studios is to teach in the way that we as human beings learn best. We learn by doing. We learn by asking questions and then seeking out the answers ourselves. We learn by experiencing and by using our senses. We as teachers are not there to give answers, but rather to be guides to God's truth and biblical teaching. When kids discover these truths themselves through experience, they are going to remember them forever.

Scope of Position

Studio Teachers guide and lead the kids in the studio the monthly Biblical story. Following a prepared lesson, the teachers invite the kids into the Biblical story. Even though much thought and preparation has gone into the studio lesson, we want our teachers to be sensitive to God's Spirit. That means sometimes deviating from the planned lesson to follow God's plan. Also as a K6 Experience Studio team member build relationships with co-volunteers, and help assimilate and train new volunteers as needed.

Position Duties

Teachers can expect to walk into a studio that has all the materials and equipment needed to teach.

Lessons are distributed electronically.

Arrive 25 minutes prior to the start of your session.

Touch base with studio shepherd to let explain any expectations you have of them (for example, they need to participate in the _____)

As kids enter the studio, make sure they have a security badge with name on it and are in the age appropriate studio,

Greet kids as they enter the room and say goodbye when they are leaving (using the proper procedure to release kids)

Call them by name (they have name tags on ☺) and ask them about their week.

Assist kids as they interact with the curriculum

Assist kids in cleaning up the studio

Become a person of influence in the kids' lives

Help welcome and integrate new shepherds with mentoring, training as well as friendships

Help build your ministry team and hold yourself accountable to them

Gifts/skills

Good written and verbal communications skills, loving, patient, reliable
Solid organizational skills, encouraging, leadership abilities
Computer skills

Serving Dates/Times

Work 2+ hours/2x a month. Class is the length of *The Cue* and add some pre and post time, so it adds up to about 2 hours a week. The “plus” comes in when a teacher spends preparing to teach the story and time praying for their kids, etc

Approximately 2.0 hours a session + **1-2 hours a week for Director responsibilities**

Serve on special occasions (Cxmas eve, Good Friday, etc.)
